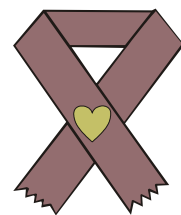
Amyloidosis is a group of diseases in which abnormal proteins accumulate in organs of the body. There are several distinct types of amyloidosis. One type is localized in the brain and is known as **Alzheimer’s Disease**. Other types affect the whole body and over 3,000 persons are diagnosed with those types each year. The most common systemic type is a bone marrow disease that can be treated with chemotherapy and stem cell transplantation with favorable results; other types can be hereditary and new treatments are being developed for these. While great progress is being made in research toward finding more effective treatments and a cure, more work needs to be done. **Awareness is important** as early diagnosis allows patients to be eligible for the best treatment options.
